- 1.8 Meeting report review and approval, June 2002, Providence, RI (2002-094): Meeting report was approved by acclamation.

2 Old Business

- 2.1 Action item review Bob Jensen: None to review.
- 2.2 Liaison letters received Bob Jensen: Items were covered in the liaison reports meeting and in the subcommittee meetings.
- 2.3 Subcommittee reports
- 2.3.1 TR-42.1 Commercial Building Cabling (2003-015): Three Addenda (2, 3 and 4) to 568-B.1 (all previously approved) will be published later this month. It was agreed to submit a project request and PINS form for Addendum 5 to 568-B.1 for telecommunications enclosures (2003-022, 2003-023) (Action: Herb Congdon). A DTE Task group meeting will be held in June.
- 2.3.2 TR-42.2 Residential Telecommunications Infrastructure (2003-021): It was agreed to send a liaison letter to SCTE on coaxial cabling testing (-030).
- 2.3.3 TR-42.3 Commercial Building Telecommunications Pathways and Spaces (2003-025): No plenary action required.
- 2.3.4 TR-42.4 Customer-owned Outside Plant Telecommunications Infrastructure (2003-031): Quorum requirements were not satisfied. It was agreed in plenary to submit a project request and PINS form for the first revision to TIA-758 (Action: Donna Ballast). It was also agreed in plenary to submit the TIA-758-A draft to industry ballot (Action: Donna Ballast).
- 2.3.5 TR-42.5 Telecommunications Infrastructure Terms and Symbols (2003-032): No plenary action required. A straw man definition for outlet is needed (Action: Bob Jensen).
- 2.3.6 TR-42.6 Telecommunications Infrastructure and Equipment Administration: No activity. TR-42.6 will go dormant until action is required.
- 2.3.7 TR-42.7 Telecommunications Copper Cabling Systems (2003-024): It was agreed, with one abstention, to send a liaison letter to IEEE on ESD (2003-029). It was agreed, with one abstention, to send a liaison letter to the US TAG for SC46C on TCL (LCL) (2003-033). A project request for the ESD TSB will be needed at the next meeting (Action: Masood Shariff).
- 2.3.8 TR-42.8 Telecommunications Optical Fiber Cabling Systems (2003-016): It was agreed to send a liaison letter to the IEEE EFM working group on fiber cable environmental performance (2003-017).
- 2.3.9 TR-42.9 Industrial Telecommunications Infrastructure (2003-026): It was agreed to send a liaison letter to IEEE requesting input on balance and common mode rejection requirements (2003-028).
- 2.4 TR-42/USTAG Meeting: No plenary action required.

- 3.1 Output documents; letters; approved standards publications: Five liaison letters will be released (one to SCTE, three to IEEE and one to the SC46C USTAG).
