Patent searches are not required to comply with the TIA IPR policy. Moreover, the Engineering Manual describes the need for members' disclosure of patents that are essential to practice TIA publications and for members to provide an indication of their willingness to license any known patents.

Dave Hess expressed concerns over subcommittee "boundary" issues due to the split in optical fiber cabling content between TIA-568-C.0 and TIA-568-C.3.

2.2.9 TR-42.12 – Optical Fibers and Cables

Paul Kolesar presented TR42-2011-06-085.

A motion to approve TIA-455-244 (FOTP-244) for publication was approved without objection.

TR-42 Chair Bob Jensen reported he will continue to work with Mike Kinard to resolve issues with TR-42.12 project approvals.

2.2.10 TR-42.13 – Interconnecting Devices and Passive Components

There was no TR-42.13 report.

David Fisher presented a consolidated list of TR-42.13 projects needing TR-42 approval (TR42-2011-06-093). A motion to approve the projects except for TSB-140 was approved without objection. Responsibility for TSB-140 will be passed to TR-42.11.

2.2.11 TR-42.16 – Bonding and Grounding

2.3 Proposed changes to TR-42 Operational Guidelines

2.3.1 Proposal for ballot documents and ballot resolution documentation

Val Maguire presented TR42-2011-06-076. The proposal was modified during the meeting to specify a PDF file for the "track changes" document and to remove the mandate that it be posted ("shall" changed to "should"). A motion to approve the proposal as modified was approved without objection. Bob Jensen will make the required changes to the TR-42 Operational Guidelines. The modified proposal was posted to the FTP site after the meeting as document TR42-2011-06-098.

Maguire agreed to draft content for TR-42 Operational Guidelines covering posting of compiled ballot comments. This will be considered at a future meeting.

Bob Jensen agreed to forward the TR-42 Operational Guidelines to the TIA TSSC.

2.3.2 Proposal for quorum maintenance

Ray Emplit presented TR42-2011-06-065. After discussion a motion to approve the proposed modifications to the TR-42 Operational Guidelines failed with a vote of 6 for, 9 against, 2 abstentions. The Task Group considering this issue was disbanded.

2.4 Program of work

Bob Jensen reminded the subcommittee vice chairs that they were responsible for maintaining their subcommittee's entries.

2.5 Other

2.5.1 Consensus deviation

The Task Group will continue its work on this issue.

2.5.2 Generic standards

A motion to continue the slate of documents with 568-C.0 contents used as "generic contents" (topics in 568-C.0 are generic and inclusive to all premises documents) was approved without objection.

3 New business and output documents

3.1 Output documents

Two outgoing liaison letters were approved (see 2.2.6).

3.2 Other

3.2.1 "D" series planning

A Task Group was formed to recommend placement of content within the "D" series of TIA-568. Bob Jensen was appointed Chair with membership consisting of subcommittee chairs and vice chairs and others who wish to participate.

3.2.2 Operational efficiency

Herb Congdon presented TR42-2011-06-090.

A Task Group was formed to provide recommendations for handling of comment resolution when the content of a document involves multiple subcommittees. Ray Emplit was appointed chair with membership consisting of subcommittee chairs and vice chairs and others who wish to participate.

Contributions affecting a document are to include a TIA cover sheet, proposed text to be included in the document, and the rationale/substantiation for the contribution. File templates are available on the TR42.3 FTP site for download. All contributions shall be submitted to the electronic document coordinator (EDC). All electronic files shall be provided in either Adobe Acrobat (*.PDF); Microsoft Word (*.DOC); Microsoft PowerPoint (*.PPT); or in Microsoft Excel(*.XLS). Compressed files shall be accessible using PKUNZIP or WINZIP (*.ZIP).

Early submittal and posting of contributions for consideration in meetings is highly encouraged. Contributions shall be submitted to the EDC as soon as possible and then posted to the FTP folders by the EDC as soon after receipt as possible, preferably within one business day. Notification of the posting shall be made to the group's email reflector

list by the EDC within one working day of the posting. All contributions shall be posted to the appropriate location on the TIA FTP site no later than 12:00 noon EST on the Monday preceding the week of the meeting in which the contribution is to be considered (example: if the meeting will be held on Thursday the 20th, the contributions shall be posted by noon on Monday the 10th).

LATE CONTRIBUTIONS:

Contributions not posted as described in the timing above shall be classified as "late contributions." They may be considered in the meeting to which they are addressed provided that an appropriate motion receives 50% or greater of a vote.

All late contributions shall be provided to the EDC and to the committee members on a memory stick or CD-ROM along with sufficient paper copies for those members without a PC. All late contributions shall be posted to the TR-42.3 FTP site within one week of meeting adjournment.
