Cheryl Blum discussed the ANSI initiative for the Electric Vehicle Standards Panel (EVSP) and submitted documents that outlined the EVSP proposal and provided a response form to be added to the contributions.

### 8. Liaison Reports

Cheryl Blum reported that ISO and ITU are joining in an ITS initiative to partner in standards development in ITS. It was noted that could result in a more vertical approach in addressing ITS standards. This is an area that TIA and TR48 should continue to monitor. It was also noted, though, that US TAG and Secretariat for ISO TC 204 ITS will be transitioned from TIA to ITS-America by May 31, 2011.

# 9. New TR48 Chairman Nominations

A nomination for TR48 chairman was submitted by Mitch Tseng. Mitch also submitted a letter of support from his organization. Mitch expressed his views for TR48 leadership in taking a refreshed view of the vehicle telematics standards landscape, and in pursuing outreach to expand participation.

#### 10. New TR48 Chairman Election

A voice vote was taken from voting members on the call. The vote was unanimous to elect Mitch Tseng as the new chairman of TR48. Committee members congratulated Mitch on being elected.

#### 9. Other Business

Other items of interest in telematics and similar areas were discussed, including:

- ATIS is looking at M2M, Smart Grid, and Connected Vehicles where M2M is providing the cross-cutting technology. ATIS was noted as making progress in the area of connected vehicles.
- AKTIV Cooperative Car project for mobile traffic channels was noted as being supported by German automakers. Of interest is that LTE is being looked at for the communications layer.
- ETSI 57<sup>th</sup> General Assembly initiated a new work item for M2M standards and forming partnerships with other SDOs for a more collective view of M2M. This may be an area for TIA to become a partner and coordination should be considered.
- Given many parallel activities to TR48, it was suggested that more time be spent in upcoming meetings to review other telematics related developments where coordination and monitoring could be enhanced.

The next monthly meeting will be held via teleconference from 10:00AM to 11:00 AM EDT on Thursday, **June 30, 2011**.
