TIA's patent policy can be found in the TIA Engineering Manual (5th edition). Participants in the work of the TIA Formulating Group are urged to review this policy. Participants are encouraged to notify TIA of any patents of which they are aware that are related to the practice of a TIA publication early on in the development of the TIA document to reduce the possibility for delays in the development process and increase the likelihood that the draft TIA publication will be approved for publication. Patent searches are not required to comply with the TIA IPR policy. Moreover, the Engineering Manual describes the need for members' disclosure of patents that are essential to practice TIA publications and for members to provide an indication of their willingness to license any known patents.

2.2 Subcommittee reports and plenary action

2.2.1 TR-42.1 – Generic Telecommunications Cabling and Premises Cabling

Ray Emplit presented TR42-2014.01-027.

A motion to deactivate TR-42.2 and move ANSI/TIA-570-B and ANSI/TIA-758-A to TR-42.1 was deferred. It will be made under item 3.2 on the agenda.

2.2.2 TR-42.2 – Residential Telecommunications Infrastructure

Ray Emplit presented TR42-2014.01-028.

A motion to deactivate TR-42.2, create a new subcommittee, and assign documents between TR-42.1 and the new subcommittee as shown in the presentation was deferred. It will be made under item 3.2 on the agenda.

2.2.3 TR-42.3 – Telecommunication Pathways and Spaces

Henry Franc presented TR42-2014-01-029.

2.2.4 TR-42.5 – Telecommunications Infrastructure Terms and Symbols

Paul Kish presented TR42-2014-01-030.

2.2.5 TR-42.6 – Telecommunications Infrastructure and Equipment Administration

Jonathan Jew presented TR42-2014-01-031.

Mr Jew added that the Subcommittee had no objection to changing the date of the October, 2015, meeting to October 12 - 16.

2.2.6 TR-42.7 – Telecommunications Copper Cabling Systems

Wayne Larson presented TR42-2014-01-032.

A motion to approve a new project to produce an addendum to ANSI/TIA-568-C.2 covering additional consideration for category 6A patch cord testing was approved without objection.

Mr Larson added that the Subcommittee had no objection to changing the date of the October, 2015, meeting to October 12 - 16

2.2.7 TR-42.9 – Industrial Telecommunications Infrastructure

Brad Woodman presented TR42-2014-01-033.

2.2.8 TR-42.10 – Sustainable Information Communications Technology

Glenn Sexton presented TR42-2014-01-034.

A motion to approve a new project for a standard entitled *Standard Process for Sustainable Information Communications Technology Manufacturers* was approved unanimously.

Mr Sexton added that, in Subcommittee elections, Julie Roy was reelected Chair and Glenn Sexton was reelected Vice Chair.

2.2.9 TR-42.11 – Optical Fiber Systems

Paul Kolesar presented TR42-2014-01-035.

A proposed liaison letter to IEEE 802.3 concerning single-mode connection return loss (TR42-2014-01-036) was approved without objection after editing. The revised liaison letter will be posted to the TR-42 FTP site as document TR42-2014-01-036a.

Mr Kolesar reported that the Subcommittee generally supported changing the date of the October, 2015, meeting to October 12 - 16, but expressed some concern about a conflict with Canadian Thanksgiving on October 12.

2.2.10 TR-42.12 – Optical Fibers and Cables

Mike Kinard presented TR42-2014-01-037

Mr Kinard clarified (on page 2 of the contribution) that the proposed memorandum of understanding was to be with ICEA. On page 5, the word "redo" should be struck from the end of the lone about FOTP-122.

Mr Kinard reported that the default ballot for ANSI/TIA-598-D had closed with two negative votes. The default ballot reaffirmed that the Subcommittee was unable to accept the comments leading to the negative votes. "Blue cards" have been sent so publication must await the response.

A motion to approve for publication ANSI/TIA-455-122-B and ANSI/TIA-598-D (see above), and ANSI/TIA-455-3-B, ANSI/TIA-455-16-A and ANSI/TIA-455-203-A if no "do not approve" votes or technical comments are received, was approved unanimously.

2.2.11 TR-42.13 – Passive Optical Devices and Fiber Optic Metrology

Greg Sandels presented TR42-2014-01-038.

Mr Sandels noted that the document number at the top of page 5 of the report should be TIA-440-C.

A motion to approve a project for a new standard entitled FOCIS 18 – Fiber Optic Connector Intermateability Standard 1x16 and 2x16 Multifiber Push-On/Multifiber Termination Push-on was approved without objection.

NOTE – The project request form is included in the report referenced above.

In response to a question by Mr Sandels, it was clarified that reaffirmation of a TIA-only (non ANSI) standard required only approval by the Subcommittee. Reaffirmation of an ANSI standard requires formal ballot.

2.2.12 TR-42.16 – Premises Bonding and Grounding

Rich Jones presented TR42-2013-01-039.

3.1.2 IEEE 802.3

It was agreed that output documents to US TAG to ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 25/WG 3 and IEEE 802.3 should appear as two separate items on future agendas.

A motion to send ANSI/TIA-568-C.2-1 draft 9d to IEEE 802.3 was approved.

3.2 Possible reorganization of TR-42 generic and premises subcommittees

A motion to deactivate TR-42.2, establish a new subcommittee, and distribute responsibility for documents according to the last slide of TR42-2014-01-028 was not approved.

A motion to deactivate TR-42.2 and assign responsibility for ANSI/TIA-570-C and ANSI/TIA-758-B to TR-42.1 was approved unanimously.
