TR-42.1 resolved committee ballot comments for the ballot of TIA-568.1-E *Commercial Building Telecommunications Cabling Standards* and authorized an ANSI ballot.

TR-42.1 approved a PAR for the revision of TSB-162-A Wireless Access Points and authorized a committee ballot.

## 2.2.2 TR-42.3 – Telecommunications Administration, Pathways, Spaces, Bonding and Grounding

Cindy Montstream presented 2019-06-082.

TIA-569-E was published as there were no negative or technical comments to the default ballot that closed before this meeting.

TR-42.3 resolved comments on TIA-607-D and authorized a default ballot, with approval to publish if there are no negative or technical comments.

TR-42.3 is reviewing the drafts to ISO/IEC 18598 Amendment 1 (amendment to AIM standard regarding administration of remote powering). Comments will be forwarded to USTAG. TR-42.3 plans to initiate adoption of the amendment as an amendment to ANSI/TIA-5018 once it has reached FDIS stage.

### 2.2.3 TR-42.5 – Telecommunications Infrastructure Terms and Symbols

Ron Tellas presented 2019-06-083.

TR-42.5 will maintain the TR-42 document list. Chairs are requested to maintain their own document status lists until the logistics can be worked out.

### 2.2.4 TR-42.7 – Telecommunications Copper Cabling Systems

Wayne Larsen presented 2019-06-084.

The mock ballot for TIA-568.5 single-pair were partially resolved.

The task group on balance of terminations completed it work.

TR-42.7 drafted a liaison response to CCCA (2019-06-092) regarding legislative actions affecting contractors for low voltage circuits & equipment. The subcommittee also formed an ad hoc to work on the issue under the leadership of Ron Tellas.

### 2.2.5 TR-42.9 – Industrial Telecommunications Infrastructure

Brad Woodman presented 2019-06-085.

ANSI/TIA-1005-A will go out for another reaffirmation ballot.

Some comments were resolved on the ballot for ANSI/TIA-1005-A-2 (Performance requirements for 1G four pair industrial cables and cabling supporting 1000BASE-T for MICE2 and MICE3 environments). The remaining comments will be deferred to the next meeting. It will probably be merged into TIA-1005-B.

ANSI/TIA-PN-PN1005-A-3 (1G industrial cabling for one pair Link Segment Type B, 1000BASE-T1 for MICE2 and MICE3 environments) is on hold until TIA-568.5 is closer to committee ballot. It too may be merged into TIA-1005-B.

TR-42.11 resolved ballot comments on TSB-5069 on Optical Fiber Channel Polarity and approved another committee ballot.
