TR-42.1 resolved industry ballot comments to TIA-4966 (Education) and approved the 2nd industry ballot.

TR-42.1 resolved committee ballot comments for TSB-162-B (Wireless Access Points) and authorized publication.

TR-42.1 approved the project request for TIA-942-B-1 Edge Data Centers and authorized a mock ballot.

TR-42.7 resolved ballot comments on ANSI/TIA-568.2-D.2 (normative version of TSB-184-A guidelines for remote powering).and authorized a default ballot with three comments.

TR-42.7 resolved ballot comments on ANSI/TIA-568.5 (single-pair cabling) and authorized an industry ballot.

TR-42.7 resolved ballot comments on ANSI/TIA-5071 (Field testing for single-pair cabling) and authorized a committee ballot.

TR-42.7 did not work on TIA-568.6 (single-pair multi-drop SPMD) and thermal performance of single-pair cables due to lack of time.

TR-42.7 is likely to have at least one interim meeting before the October meetings.

2.2.5. TR-42.9 – Industrial Telecommunications Infrastructure

Brad Woodman presented TR42-2020-06-097.

TR-42.9 resolved mock ballot comments to TIA-1005-B (revision to TIA-1005-A) and authorized the 1st committee ballot.

TR-42.9 reviewed the scope of the TIA-568.7 Industrial Single-Pair Ethernet project. Task Group will meet to continue work on the project.

2.2.6. TR-42.11 – Optical Fiber Systems

Phil Irwin presented TR42-2020-06-098.

TSB-5069 (Optical Fiber Channel Polarity for single and double row fiber) was approved for publication at the last meeting.

TR-42.11 reviewed the draft for ANSI/TIA-568.3-E (Optical Fiber Cabling and Components) and approved issuing the 1st committee ballot with content from TIA-568.3-D-1 added. Sunny Xu was appointed as editor.

TR-42.11 approved issuing a ballot for TIA-526-14-D (Optical Power Loss Measurement of Installed Multimode Fiber Cable Plant) as an adoption of IEC 61280-4-1 ed.3 2019) with content of the foreword to be determined.

2.2.7. TR-42.12 - Optical Fibers and Cables

Patrick Van Vickle presented TR42-2020-06-099.

TR-42.12 resolved comments on TIA-455-3 (FOTP-3) Temperature Ramps and Precision

The previously planned 'Munsell sheet' round robin to understand the sources of color variability for the revision of ANSI/TIA-598-D (Optical Fiber Color Coding) has been delayed. A new round robin proposed on CIELAB measurements of ink draw-down samples via shipping samples using individual manufacturers equipment.

TIA-455-111 (FOTP-111), fiber curl, adoption of IEC 60793-1-34 will be balloted after the October TR-42.12 meeting, as IEC 60793-1-34 is expected to be published in August 2020.

The ballot for TIA-455-244 (FOTP-244), Temperature cycling of expressed tubes, closed and TR-42.12 approved in for publication (likely in July).

Notification of the posting shall be made to the group's email reflector list by the EDC within one working day of the posting.
