7. Review of Meeting Report from Previous Meetings

The TR-45 Committee 03 September 2014 meeting report numbered TR45/14.12.08.02 was provided. The meeting report was approved with no objections.

8. Elections

There were no objections to Jane Brownley of Alcatel-Lucent to continue for another term (2015-2016) as Chair of TIA TR-45. Document .20 was provided for information.

9. Reports

9a. TR-45.3 Subcommittee

J.Ragsdale presented document .03 as the TR-45.3 report to TR-45 for information. It was reported that the TDMA-SC transposition package towards M.1457-12 was accepted by ITU-R WP 5D and included in the draft revision sent to Study Group 5. In addition, agreement was reached with ATIS for the three 136-36x parts which have now been transferred to ATIS and TIA TR-45.3 will no longer maintain these documents. Thus, there is no longer the need for TIA TR-45.3 to partner with ATIS WTSC to provide updates to M.1457 for TDMA-SC going forward. Furthermore, it was reported that it is anticipated that no further development will take place for the TIA/EIA-136 standards. Revision I has exhausted the Protocol Version code space.

It was reported that TR-45.5 in conjunction with 3GPP2 TSG-AC provided a response liaison to ITU-R WP 5D on the intent to update Recommendation ITU-R M.1457 to Revision 13 for CDMA-MC. In addition, it was reported that updates were provided on the working document towards a preliminary draft new ITU-R Report on the Smart Grid project.

9d. TR-45.8 Subcommittee

B.Covell presented document .06r1 as the TR-45.8 report to TR-45 for information. David Crowe of Cellular Networking Perspectives (CNP) was affirmed with no objections as the new Chair of Subcommittee TR-45.8 effective 01 January 2015. TR-45 expressed its gratitude and thanked Betsy Covell of Alcatel-Lucent for her years of support, commitment, and dedication to TR-45.8 serving as the Subcommittee Chair.

It was reported that a new ATIS Work Item (Issue Statement) has been proposed *for Location Accuracy Improvements for Emergency Calls*. This WI will not impact text-to-911 but could impact J-STD-036-C. TR-45.8 has sent correspondence to ATIS WTSC SN indicating its support for working with them on any impact to J-STD-036-C.

Regarding the JCMAS work, the joint project to add Spanish language alerts to JCMAS is on hold. ATIS completed their work to add Spanish language alerts to CMAS. Recently, FEMA has recommended an alternate approach to the approach ATIS WTSC-SN standardized for CMAS Spanish-language support which may affect the joint project. The joint project on Canadian Commercial Mobile Alerts Service (CMAS) is on hold, pending input on Canadian CMAS requirements.

Regarding the JSMS911 work, several meetings have been held to progress the enhancements to J-STD-110. The development of support for MMS to 9-1-1 has started, with a number of agreements having been reached to provide direction for future contributions.

It was reported that TIA has started the first beta testing stage of the TIA MEID database Phase 1 in July 2014 and the phased rollout is anticipated in the February 2015 timeframe.
