1 Call to order

Individual participants are encouraged to notify TIA of any patent(s) or published pending patent application(s) of which they are aware that may be essential to the practice of a proposed TIA Publication, including requirements introduced through normative references, early on in the development to reduce the possibility for delays in the development process and increase the likelihood that the proposed TIA Publication will become a Standard. However, a Patent Holder who has provided TIA with a TIA Patent Holder Statement with respect to the applicable proposed TIA Publication need not (but may elect to) identify its specific patent(s) or published pending patent application(s) that may be essential to the practice of the proposed TIA Publication in question. Patent searches are not required to comply with the TIA Intellectual Property Rights Policy.

Participants in the work of the TR-51 were urged to review this policy. Participants were encouraged to notify TIA of any patents of which they are aware that are related to the practice of TIA publication early

The plan going forward is to create a set of revisions incorporating the comments, to upload a clean (all changes accepted) PDF for balloting and then create a directory on the TR-51 ftp site with both the clean and edited versions to support the review process. A votes will be held at future meeting to authorize re-balloting these documents.
