1 Administrative

1.1 The Meeting

1.2 The Meeting Report

The Report of Meeting Number 223 (TR-30/04-06-003), March 5, 2004, was reviewed and approved.

1.3 IPR Statements

The Chair encouraged anyone who was aware of IP that relates to the work of TR-30 or its subcommittees to make the appropriate statements as early as possible in the process. The Chair directed the members to the TIA Engineering Manual, and the TIA web site (www.tiaonline.org), for the specific requirements.

1.4 TR-30.5

The Chair indicated that since the March meeting, he had sent an email to the TR-30.5 reflector suggesting various approaches which could be taken to continue the work of the sub-committee. All but one of the responses recommended that the work be moved into one of the other TR-30 sub-committees. It would appear that the best sub-committee to move this work to would be TR-30.1. The Chair will ask TR-30.1 to consider this at their August meeting. A final decision on TR-30.5 will be made at the August TR-30 meeting.

1.5 Creation of a new Sub-Committee

The Chair reported that he had contacted the US ITAC-T Study Group B leadership regarding the proposed creation of a new TR-30 sub-committee for review of contributions going to ITU-T Study Group 16 Working Party 2. The SG-B leadership indicated that they had been contacted by a number of companies who had indicated that they were not in favor of the formation of this new subcommittee. The SG-B leadership felt that since there was insufficient industry support for this, there seemed little point in continuing with a new sub-committee. TR-30 was thanked for trying to provide the support that had been requested. The Chair indicated that this subject was closed at this time.

2 International Meetings

The Chair reported that the next international meeting related to the work of TR-30 will be a joint TR-30.1/Question 11/16 Rapporteurs meeting the week of August 9th in Washington, DC.
