**1 Administrative****1.1 The Meeting**

The Chair, Mr. Fred Lucas, called the meeting to order at 10:35 a.m. on Friday, June 17, 2005. The meeting was held at TIA Headquarters, Arlington, VA. Mr. Lucas announced that a quorum was present.

**1.2 Agenda**

The agenda (TR-30/05-06-006R1) for the meeting was accepted.

**1.3 The Meeting Report**

The Report of Meeting Number 227 (TR-30/05-06-005), March 1, 2005, was reviewed and approved.

**1.4 IPR Statements**

The Chair encouraged anyone who was aware of IP that relates to the work of TR-30 or its subcommittees to make the appropriate statements as early as possible in the

process. The Chair directed the members to the TIA Engineering Manual, and the TIA web site ([www.tiaonline.org](http://www.tiaonline.org)), for the specific requirements.

## 2 International Meetings

The Chair indicated that the US Study Group B meeting to prepare for the ITU-T Study Group 16 meeting is scheduled for June 29, 2005. The Study Group 16 meeting is July 26 – August 5, 2005 in Geneva, Switzerland.

## 3 Subcommittee Activities and Actions

### 3.1 TR-30.1

Mr. Chu, TR-30.1 Chair, reported that two standards, TIA-578-B and TIA/EIA-592-A, were brought to TR-30.1 for 5 year review. These originally had been in TR-30.5. Both are “AT command” standards which would be better addressed in TR-30.2. TR-30.1 has agreed that it is appropriate to move this work to TR-30.2.

Mr. Chu reported that one contribution destined to ITU-T Study Group 16 was approved as a company contribution (TR-30/05-06-007). Mr. Chu reported that some modification of the contribution will be made as a result of TR-30.1 discussion. TR-30 also approved this as a company contribution.

### 3.2 TR-30.2

Mr. Lucas, TR-30.2 Chair, reported that the ballot for the revision of TSB-89 was approved with only editorial comments. Mr. Lucas also reported that TR-30.2 had agreed to send 7 standards to ballot for reaffirmation.

### 3.3 TR-30.3

Mr. Lucas reported that TR-30.3 had approved PN-3-0062, *Network Model for Evaluating Multimedia Transmission Performance Over Internet Protocol*, for industry ballot. TR-30 agreed with this decision.
