Exceptions to the foregoing may be granted or permitted in writing to the Chair of the Formulating Group by the head of TIA’s Standards Program on a case-by-case basis.”
- **Intellectual Property Rights (Early Disclosure Policy)**
- The chairman read the TIA IPR statement, as found in the TIA Standards Development Procedures.
- “TIA’s Intellectual Property Rights Policy can be found in Statements of Policy (ANNEX D) and other clauses and annexes of this document. Participants in the work of the TIA Formulating Groups are urged to review the appropriate sections. - **ANSI/TIA-322**
- At the October 2014 quorum meeting TR-14 committee voted to open new ANSI project: *ANSI TIA-322 Loading Criteria, Analysis, and Design Related to the Installation, Alteration and Maintenance of Communication Structures*. To initiate the work on the draft document, there is a need to create a Task Group, which will provide the draft of ANSI/TIA-322.

- Mr. Ernie Jones comments: ASSE committee has until the end of October 2015 on the acceptance A10.48 standard. Expectation is it will be approved with comments. Comments must be addressed, then it will be placed in final draft form. A10.48 will be released for public ballot afterwards, which then must be left open for 3 months. The expectation is the balloting period will end in February 2016, and will be submitted for publication after this time. A number of definitions have been updated to ensure consistency between A10.48 and ANSI/TIA-322.
- John Erichsen: Expectation is to publish ANSI/TIA-322 by February 2016. Initial discussion / development will be limited and new project for ANSI/TIA-322-A will be opened to initiate second round. Much greater development will be expected at that time. Initial version of ANSI/TIA-322 will be developed largely by the editorial group and is largely consistent with engineering standards from ANSI/TIA-1019-A.

- **Status update of TIA TR-14 Task Group 3 for ANSI/TIA-222-H by chairman of the Task Group Mr. Mark Malouf**
- Mark recently returned from the IASS meeting in September and noted the TIA-222-G standard is being used worldwide, especially in emerging markets. In some locations it is even used in favor of the existing standards, due to its practicality.
- Number of sub-task groups are still working on action lists.
- Anticipate having a draft document ready for review by the next face / face meeting. New members who are interested in contributing are welcomed. Contact Mr. Mark Malouf about interest, specifically which section, and communication will be made with sub-chair group.
- **Technical Bulletin for Mount Classification Sub-Task Group**
- Sub-Task Group falls within the TIA TR-14 Task Group 3 for ANSI/TIA-222-H which is chaired by Mr. Mark Malouf
- Sub-Task Group Chairman: Michell Miller, SSOE (mlmiller@ssoe.com)
- Questions: Vicor Allen, AT&T Mobility, Does Rev. G require original mount analysis, but not for tower reanalysis?
- John Erichsen: Mount analysis is required as needed by the Engineer of Record, owner and other responsible parties. Concern over mount analysis is due to larger weight being installed on mounts now, vs. 5 – 10 year earlier.
- David Brinker: Mount standard has some additional loading combinations, beyond what is in TIA-222-G, to ensure specific mount classification. Everything that is needed to analyze a mount is in TIA-222-G. The mount standard is to establish classification, which allows the user to avoid having to complete a rigorous analysis each time loading is changed.
