## 6. Correspondence and Liaisons

Tony Noerpel (Chair) presented an oral ETSI meeting report identifying mobile satellite activities and meetings of ETSI SES MSS working group including the upcoming meeting MSS #5 in Cambridge, England on May 18-20. MSS activities include new air interface specifications and S-band emissions requirements.

Tony Noerpel (Chair) presented an oral ETSI meeting report identifying fixed satellite activities and meetings of ETSI SES BSM working group including the upcoming meeting BSM #40 in Sophia Antipolis, France on June 5.

Lars reported on DVB. Progress had been made on new DVB-RCS standards. This working group is being chaired by Harald Skinnemoen. The next meeting is DVB-RCS #55 May 14-15, Geneva, Switzerland.

Lars reported on Satlabs. Certification testing for DVB terminals has been completed up to version 2.1. A test plan exists for validation of HUBs as well.

## 7. Ballot Results

TR 34.1 approved unanimously joint publication of ETSI TR 102-602 and ETSI TR 102-603.

TR 34.1 approved unanimously withdrawal of TIA/EIA 1088, PN-3-0226, "SMCP: Satellite Network Modem System (SNMS) Mesh Control Protocol"

## 8. Working Group Activities

### GMR

Revisions of GMR1 will be pursued for standardization in TIA including IuPS based on a 3GPP core network. Cross publication of the GMR-1 3G specification which has been approved at the working group level in ETSI SES MSS already will be pursued.

Cross publication of other ETSI MSS standards to be pursued.

### IPoS

No activity

### C2P

ETSI TS 102 602 and TR 102 603 have been published by ETSI SES which should supersede and replace TIA 1088 IP Modem SNMS Standard connection control protocol.

### DVB

Lars reported on a new standard for DVB-RCS-2 or next generation. The next meeting will take place in Geneva on May 14-15.

Lars reported that SATLABs version 2 test bed is ready by the end of the year.

Lars also reported on hub interoperability progress.

Prakash Chitre recommended we solicit suggestions from members for new work activities for the new year and solicit new members.
