2 **7. Review of Meeting Report from Previous Meetings**

3 The TR-45 Committee 4-5 September 2013 meeting report numbered TR45/13.12.09.02 was reviewed. A
4 motion was made by G.Pellegrino and seconded by O.Pearson to approve the meeting report provided in
5 document .02. The motion passed with no objections.

7 **8. TR-45 Vice-Chair Election**

By acclamation, Mark Lipford of Sprint was confirmed as the Vice-Chair of TIA Engineering Committee TR-45 for the 2014-2015 term. Document .29 was provided for information.

9. Reports

9a. TR-45.3 Subcommittee

J.Ragsdale presented document .03 as the TR-45.3 report to TR-45 for information.

9b. TR-45.4 Subcommittee

D.Ott presented document .04 as the TR-45.4 report to TR-45 for information. TR-45 confirmed the election of David Ott of Qualcomm to continue to serve as the TR-45.4 Chair. It was noted that the TR-45.4 Vice-Chair position remains open.

9c. TR-45.5 Subcommittee

O. Pearson presented document .05 as the TR-45.5 report to TR-45 for information. TR-45 confirmed the election by acclamation of Orlett W. Pearson of Alcatel-Lucent to retain the TR-45.5 Chair position. Document .33 was provided for information. Regarding the joint ATIS/TIA Standard on Coexistence and Interference Issues in Land Mobile Systems, it was reported that the standard J-STD-111 was approved for another default ballot due to TIA legal comments. The default ballot is scheduled to close in January 2014. The expectation is that there will be no additional ballot comments to address and the joint standard will be approved for publication soon thereafter.

9d. TR-45.8 Subcommittee

B. Covell provided document .06 with attachments a-b as the TR-45.8 report to TR-45 for information.

Regarding JCMAS, it was reported once again that the joint project to add Spanish language alerts to JCMAS is on hold. ATIS completed their work to add Spanish language alerts to CMAS. Recently, FEMA has recommended an alternate approach to the WTSC-SN standardized for CMAS Spanish-language support which may affect the joint project. In addition, the joint project on Canadian Commercial Mobile Alerts Service (CMAS) is on hold, pending input on Canadian CMAS requirements.

Regarding JSMS911, it was reported that the work continues on CMRS and TCC Provider Implementation Guidelines for the Joint ATIS/TIA SMS to 911 Standard (J-STD-110). The implementation guidelines were approved for ballot on September 19. Ballot comment resolution was held on November 6. The document was approved for publication as J-STD-110-01 by administrative ballot ending on November 25 and was published on November 26.

9e. Ad Hoc on Authentication Group (AHAG)

Document .07 was provided by F.Quick as the AHAG report to TR-45 for information. The publication ready version of TIA-4999 was provided in document .07C.

Document .09a contains the publication ready version of the Guidelines (SX00-20131202-101EA SC.R4002-0_v10.0_GHA_Guidelines_for_MEID_ proposed

publication CLEAN.pdf). The Guidelines were approved by TR-45 to be transcribed to the TIA version by Editor once the 3GPP2 SC approval process is completed. There were no objections.
