### 25 8c AHG on ESN/UIM/MEID (EUMAG) – G. Pellegrino & J. Derr

27 While the group hasn't met since the last TR-45 meeting, it was noted that GSMA has provided additional  
28 information that will impact the "GHA (Global Hexadecimal Administrator) Assignment Guidelines and  
29 Procedures for Mobile Equipment Identifier (MEID) and Short Form Expanded UIM Identifier (SF\_EUIMID)"  
30 document.

31 Testing on the MEID database is complete. Additional legal review continues. Organizations wanting access to  
32 the database will need to sign a non-disclosure agreement (NDA).
