TR48-20110825-003<u>R1</u>: Kevin Lu (Telcordia) provided an introduction on the Connected Vehicle Applications. As part of the US ITS work, the work on Connected Vehicles has been focus on developing

- Safety Applications, including
  - (i) Vehicle to Vehicle (V2V) Communications for Safety and
  - (ii) Vehicle to Infrastructure (V2I and I2V) Communications for Safety
- Mobility Applications, including
  - (i) Real-Time Data Capture and Management
  - (ii) Dynamic Mobility Applications (DMA)

- Environmental Applications, including
  - (i) Applications for the Environment: Real-Time Information Synthesis (AERIS)
  - (ii) Road Weather Applications for Connected Vehicles

The presentation provided an extensive list of Standards, which are related to the work. The presentation also recommended that

- (i) Core System ConOps, requirements, and architecture could be further developed into standards.
- (ii) DMA and AERIS applications could be delivered over cellular communications.
- (iii) Existing DMA or AERIS use cases should be updated and aligned with Core System ConOps, requirement, and architecture.
- (iv) These use cases could be further contributed to M2M consolidation effort.

There is no liaison report in this meeting.

#### 9. Other Business

There is an IOSO/ITU workshop in Kyoto in August. The Chair will look into if there are information can be shared.

The ITS World Congress will be in Orlando on October 18-20.
