8. Liaison Reports

IEEE (Tom Kurihara): ETSI TC-ITS has benefited from the MOU with IEEE to get the 802.11 and 1609.2 documents for their use to build profiles for the EC. Moreover, IEEE 802.11-2012 (a,k,a, 802.11p) is approved for publication. (Chair's note: 802.11-2012 is on sale from IEEE for

only \$5. All 2700 pages of it. Go to www.techstreet.com, search for 802.11, and make a buy or not to buy decision.)

ISO TC204 (Mitch Tseng): The Chair assumed the Rapporteur og WG16 which is focusing on developing the protocol stadnards for Intelligent Transport Systems (ITS). The Chair volunteered as the liaison for TC204 to provide updates and opportunities for joint work or transpose of standards between ISO and TIA.

9. Other Business

The group spent some time discussing the work plan. The conclusion is to investigate the standard opportunities form two (three) streams: (1) through ISO TC 204 on ITS; (2) Work with USDOT by turning the Federal Guidelines into appropriate standards; and (3) Tentatively, work with FMCSA/MCSAC on Safety related Standards. The means are as following:

- 1. ISO TC204: Seeking synergies and also possible regional requirements that specifically for North America. Also, if ISO allows, transpose ISO standards into TIA/ANSI standards. This work will be led by Mitch Tseng.
- 2. USDOT: Since USDOT publication is not necessary in the standard format, it is most sutable for TR-48 to chip in efforts to publish standards. Currently, TR-48 is investigating the possibility to transpose USDOT publications such as CoreSys into TR-48 standard. This effort will be led by Kevin Lu and Tom Kurihara.
- 3. FMCSA/MCSAC: This area is listed as "Tentative" as Dave Kraft is still checking with MCSAC and FMCSA and explore if this is of interest to FMCSA. The focus will be on Safety for driving (electronic driver logs for large commercial vehicles). According to the discussion in last meeting, this effort may need some standards assistance in defining standardized methods for electronic data transfers of driver log data via commercial vehicle telematics networks and services. It addition to technical vetting of the technical requirements, the standards process should apply an effective patents policy to identify and resolve any intellection property considerations related to standards to be included in regulatory requirements. This work, if started, will be led by Dave Kraft.

It is appears that TR-48 members appear willing to support these efforts; and, it is expected that these initiative may draw other commercial vehicle telematics providers to TR-48. The Chair is assigned an action item to come up with a detailed work plan.

Kevin Lu reported that due to corporate downsizing, he will be leaving Ericsson (Telcordia) in March. He will continue serve as the Director of Standards Development (2012–2013) for the IEEE Communications Society. The Chair invited him to continue participating in future TR-48 meetings. Kevin indicated that he had prepared an article for ISO Focus+ Magazine to introduce the Cooperative Intelligent Transport Systems (C-ITS) and its progress. He will share after the paper is published. (Chair's note: See ISO *Focus+ Magazine* February 2012 issue: "All-in-one, Making connected vehicle possible", pp 23-25.
