8. Liaison Reports

CVTA (Scott McCormic): CVTA continues working on the vehicle data ownership and privacy issues. The ownership of the vehicle data, e.g. location and driver info, has been a sticky issue especially when the current privacy laws may not be adequately govern the matter.

FMCSA (Dave Kraft): No Report.

IEEE 1609 Working Group (Tom Kurihala): No Report.

ISO TC204 WG16 (Mitch Tseng): There was a TC204 WG16 Meeting on December 3~7 in San Diego, CA. The group continues to working on architecture and protocols for ITS Stations. The work on LTE, CoAP, 6LowPAN as transport, Probe Data, and Diaster Communication Preemption were the focus of the discussions. The group spent sometime to discuss marketing strategy to promote ITS. Moreover, the DSRC test in Michigan is close to final stage but no official results were reported.

oneM2M (Mitch Tseng): The eighth oneM2M Technical Plenary (TP) meeting (TP #8) was held in Miyazaki, Japan on December 9 through 13. Although the meeting had not officially closed at the time of the TR-48 meeting, oneM2M TP is on its track to have the first release published in July 2014. The current architecture is based on the "Resource-oriented Architecture (RoA)";

however, there is a new work item based on the "Service-oriented Architecture" was proposed. Although SoA has been commonly adopted in the existing M2M services, it was not taken into consideration due to "legacy work" from ETSI TC M2M. It is expected that the new work item will have significance influence to the future release of the oneM2M standards. The next TP meeting (TP #9) will be held in Mobile Alabama on February 17 through 21, 2014. The features in architecture will be frozen by then so that the Protocol working group can take over.

ITU-T Study Group 16 (ITU-T SG 16) (Scott Pennock): No Report.

TIA Government Afaire (Brian Scarpelli): No Report.

9. Other Business

The Chair and Vice Chair positions are up for new elections in the first meeting of 2014. The announcement and the nomination and its required supporting documents will be sent out by TIA.
