30 Contribution TR50-20101006-005, information on the ITU-T Smart Grid Focus Group, was presented.
31 It was noted that while TIA is not a member of the ITU, it can still contribute to the focus group and
32 will do so, considering several TIA committees are engaged in standards work related to smart grid
33 devices and communications. Therefore, TIA will contribute TR-50 input to the ITU focus group.

35 A verbal update on collaboration efforts with Georgia Tech regarding security was given. It was
36 noted that a meeting to explore the next steps to move the security standards development forward is
37 being planned.
