1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by the Chair, at 9:07 AM CDT, on July 12, 2012.

John Notor, Smart Utility Network Alliance, is the Secretary for TR-51.

2. Attendee Introductions and E-Sign-In

The attendees introduced themselves. They were directed to use the e-roster systems to sign-in to the meeting.

Remote participants used the GoToMeeting service made available for this purpose.

Quorum was established with 10 of 10 member companies present.

3. Chairs remarks

The Chair offered brief opening remarks.

4. Intellectual Property Rights

The attendees were directed to note the IPR statement on the agenda and requested to make it known if there are any patents related to the work of the committee.

5. Review and Approve Agenda

The agenda, TR51-20120712-002_Meeting_Agenda.doc, was reviewed and approved without objection.

6. Review and Approve the July 5, 2012, Meeting Report

The July 5, 2012, meeting report, TR51-20120705-003_meeting_report_for_July_5_2012.doc, was reviewed and approved without objection.

7. Technical Contributions – Layer 1

The Chair reported that the TIA has signed the MOU with IEEE, IEEE is the process of signing now. The Chair will contact IEEE with the cross reference of copyrighted material in L1 derived from IEEE 802.15.4 and proceed from there.

8. Technical Contributions – Layer 2

Phil Beecher, Beecher Communications Consultants, Ltd, introduced the Layer 2 discussion. Larry Taylor, Discrete Time Communications, described the current status of the draft, and changes made since the last L2 Ad Hoc, working through the comment spreadsheet, ANSI_TIA-PN4957_200_d1 Consolidated Comments 0v193.xlsx, and the changes to the current draft, ANSI_TIA-PN4957_200_d2 0v193.pdf.

Larry reported that all comments have been addressed and draft 0v193 edits are up to date.

Larry discussed a possible edit in connection with the Channel Function and Operating Class as a possible change.

Phil Beecher opened the discussion to comments. Larry Taylor took questions and replied to the questions/comments. There was considerable discussion about Information Element ID assignments and the relationship between the IEEE 802.15.4 approach and the TR-51 approach. The proposed approach was clarified at the end of the discussion.

The Chair extended the call to 10:30 AM CDT, and the meeting continued, discussing the edits proposed by Larry Taylor to the to the Channel Function text. There was some discussion about this issue focused on clarifying the details.

The Chair recessed the meeting at 10:03 AM CDT.

The Chair reopened the meeting at 10:18 AM.

There was a continuation of the discussion about how to handle the definition of the Channel Function text related to the channel table and the operating class.

A proposal was made to recess the meeting until Friday July 13, at 9:00 AM CDT. The Chair agreed to recess the meeting until that time.

The Chair recessed at 10:39 AM until Friday July 13, 2012, at 9:00 AM CDT.

The Chair reconvened the meeting on Friday July 13, 2012, at 9:03 AM CDT.

The Secretary verified that a quorum, 7 of 10 member companies, were present.

The Chair turned the meeting over to Phil Beecher, who, in turn, turned the meeting over to Larry Taylor to present the updates to the Comment Spreadsheet, ANSI_TIA-PN4957_200_d1 Consolidated Comments 0v194.xlsx, and the L2 Draft, ANSI_TIA-PN4957_200_d2 0v1942.pdf.

Larry discussed the changes made to the draft related to the Channel Function.

There was a consensus on the call that these changes were appropriate.

Larry sent updated documents to the Secretary who posted them.

The Chair reported that OneM2M, a 3GPP-like organization, is having a meeting next week. The Chair plans to follow up on the copyright issues related to the L1 specification with the IEEE SA.

12. 2012 Meeting Schedule

The meeting schedule going forward was reviewed. The Chair discussed the possibility of a meeting after the scheduled September face to face meeting.

The Secretary suggested that the July 19 teleconference meeting be cancelled. There were no objections, so it was cancelled.
