8. Status of Submission of the ANSI/TIA 4957 Standard to ISO and Published TR-51 Stds

Jeff Hannah reported that ANSI/TIA 4957.210, is published and .300, and .400 are about to be published, pending minor editorial changes.

Jeff Hannah reported that the TR-51 committee has done everything that is needed. John Notor reported that the presently formulated committees in ISO JTC1 do not include the scope of the 4957 standard. Jeff reported that the new committee needs to have 3 companies participating in order to form the committee.

Larry Taylor offered to contact his colleagues to determine if there is another way to go, which was agreed to by consensus.

9. Other Business

The Chair opened the issue of scheduling new meetings for TR-51.
