MEETING REPORT TIA TR-51 Smart Utility Networks Monday, March 31, 2014 Teleconference Meeting 11 AM to 1 PM ET

1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Michael Lynch, 8:04 AM PDT, on March 31, 2014.

7. Submission of 4957 Series to SGIP2

Report from Jeff Hannah on the status of the need for a wireless matrix submission to SGIP2. Jeff reports that the portal has been created to allow SGIP to view the 4957 series to work on getting it approved to the catalog of standards. Jeff also reports that the wireless matrix has moved off the priority list of SGIP.

There was a conversation about IEEE 802 and TIA doing a joint catalog of standards, rather than trying to get 4957 submitted to SGIP2. The question for future discussions is 'What organizations could TIA work with to further the adoption of the 4957 series?'

There is also work in IEEE 802 in response to ITU-R Question 236/1, which could include adding TR-51 to the report as a standard related to 802.15.4.

The question of how 4957 is being marketed came up. One response to this points to the visibility resulting from getting the standard into the Question 236/1 report. As this report matures, there may be opportunities to focus attention on the 4957 series via press releases from TIA.

The suggestion was made is a need for a more focused marketing plan to evangelize the 4957 series standard. There was support for this idea. There has not been a significant effort by TIA to market the standard. The suggestion was to focus on creating a marketing strategy in the face to face meeting on April 14.

8. Planned revisions to 4957 Series

The planned revisions are tied to the revisions being done in Wi-SUN. It is taking more time than intended. Again this will be discussed further in the April 14 face to face meeting.
