1 Call to order

The meeting was called to order at 8:08 AM Eastern Time.

The Chair welcomed participants and the Secretary announced the sign in code "8664".

2 Attendance

The Secretary took attendance by roll call. A quorum was present, 6 of 7 voters in attendance. The Chair returned to the formal agenda at this point. For a list of attendees, see ANNEX A.

3 Notice of Participation

The attendees were reminded to review the notice of participation. The members present agreed to abide by the terms of the Notice.

Exceptions to the foregoing may be granted or permitted in writing to the Chair of the Formulating Group by the head of the TIA Standards Department on a case-by-case basis.

4 Intellectual property rights

The Chair reminded the participants about the TIA IPR statement, as found in the TIA Standards Development Procedures.

TIA's Intellectual Property Rights Policy can be found in Statements of Policy (ANNEX C) and other clauses and annexes of TIA Standards Development Procedures. Participants in the work of the TIA Formulating Groups are urged to review the appropriate sections. Individual participants are encouraged to notify TIA of any patent(s) or published pending patent application(s) of which they are aware that may be essential to the practice of a proposed TIA Publication, including requirements introduced through normative references, early on in the development to reduce the possibility for delays in the development process and increase the likelihood that the proposed TIA Publication will become a Standard. However, a Patent Holder who has provided TIA with a TIA Patent Holder Statement with respect to the applicable proposed TIA Publication need not (but may elect to) identify its specific patent(s) or published pending patent application(s) that may be essential to the practice of the proposed TIA Publication in question. Patent searches are not required to comply with the TIA Intellectual Property Rights Policy.

Participants in the work of the TR-51 were urged to review this policy. Participants were encouraged to notify TIA of any patents of which they are aware that are related to the practice of TIA publication early

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in the development of the TIA document to reduce the possibility for delays in the development process and increase the likelihood that the draft TIA publication will be approved for publication.

The Chair asked if any participant was aware of new patents, the use of which might be essential to any documents being considered by TR-51.

9 New Business

9.1 Planned Revisions to 4957 Series Standard

Don Sturek presented the contribution 20160122-Wi-SUN-FAN-TIA-TR51-WG3-Status-Atlanta, and reviewed the state of ANSI_TIA_PN4957.000a_Overview_0v01.docx, and, with Marianna Kramarikova, reviewed the modifications proposed for the document, which are shown in ANSI_TIA_PN4957.000a_Overview_0v01_MK.DOCX.

The discussion included concerns that the original MS WordTM versions of the published standards may have been lost in the TIA archives. John Notor offered, which was accepted, to post the pre-publication drafts to the TR-51 ftp site to help recreate the originals, which did not include the 4957.000 standard. Kunal Shah agreed to provide the 4957.000 file. Phil Beecher reported that the original MS VisioTM artwork was missing as well. Don Sturek noted that Chin Sean Sum is providing editorial support for the updates to the 4957 series of standards.

After discussion, the group decided to create a new volume, 4957.500, Security, which will contain most of the security specifications and implementation information. The following motion was made and voted on.

Motion: To open ANSI project 4957.500, Security, which will focus on authentication, key establishment and provisioning of data link keys within the 4957 series of standards.

 Late December 2015, TIA had a productive call with Dr. Rangam Subramaniam, Technology and Spectrum Policy Strategist at National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA). Marianna provided a brief overview of NTIA and Dr. Rangam's division of spectrum planning. There is an interest to work together and possibly present together at TIA-2016.

Dr. Rangam brought to TIA's attention the FCC workshop on Model City which took place on April 15th, 2015. Recording of the event can be found HERE.
