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1. Call to Order

The Chair called the meeting to order at 1:06 pm local time, June 20, 2018 and recorded the meeting notes.

2. Record of Attendance



A list of attendees is attached. As a result of the roll call, a quorum was determined to be present. The Chair noted that the TIA Participation Notice and the TIA Important Notice of Participation had been read earlier in the day.

3. Review and Approve Agenda

TIA published the agenda prior to this meeting. The agenda was also available on the TIA server as "TR8-18-007_TR-8_Meeting_Notice_Agenda 2018_6_20 REV 1.pdf". Dwight Smith moved to approve the agenda and John Lambrou seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously by voice vote.

4. Review and Approve Last Meeting Report

TIA published the last TR-8 Meeting Report also available on the meeting server as "TR8-18-004_TR-8_Meeting_2018_02_07_Meeting_Report_Approved version.pdf". Dwight Smith moved to approve the Meeting Report and Chris Maiers seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously by voice vote.

5. TIA IPR Policy

The Chair noted that the TIA patent policy and early disclosure request had been read earlier in the day and asked if there was knowledge of patents, the use of which may be essential to any document being considered during this meeting that anyone would like to disclose at this time. No new IPR was identified.

6. Review Status of Old Assignments

The Chair noted that at the quorum meeting held in February, there was agreement to extend the review period for the latest revision of the draft PAM Tool Schema document (TR8-17-007-R1). The Chair noted that Motorola had submitted comments (TR8-17-020-R2 MSI Comments on TR8-17-007-R1.docx) and asked the author for a status update. Jim Holthaus reported that comments had also been received from EF Johnson but he had not had time to combine the comment matrices and provide author responses. Once a combined comment matrix with author responses is provided, the Chair will determine if a Working Group 1 conference call is needed for comment resolution discussions.

The Chair noted that updated versions of the informal TR-8 document tracking spreadsheet (TR8-18-005_TR8docs.xlsx) and project tracking spreadsheet (TR8-18-006_TR8projs.xlsx) were available on the server.

The chair noted that after the February quorum meeting two documents had been approved by the Steering Committee for inclusion in the P25 suite of Standards:

19. TR-8.21 Intrinsic Safety - Lambrou

The TR-8.21 Chair (John Lambrou) reported that TR-8.17 did hold a quorum meeting during the week. During the meeting David Malohn of UL LLC was elected vice chair. John also reported that a revision of ANSI/TIA-4950-A "Requirements for Battery-Powered, Portable



Land Mobile Radio Applications in Class I, II, and III, Division 1, Hazardous (Classified) Locations" is in progress.

20. TR-8.25 Compliance Assessment - Holthaus

The TR-8.25 Chair (Jim Holthaus) reported that TR-8.25 did hold a quorum meeting during the week. Jim reported that additional comments on the revision of TSB-102.CBBK-B (ISSI/CSSI RCAT revision) had been received from Motorola. During the meeting, the comments were agreed to and pending submission of an updated comment matrix and modified document, the revision was approved for ballot.

Jim also reported that during the meeting the TIA-102.CABA-A "Interoperability Testing for Voice Operation in Conventional Systems" revision was approved for ballot.

21. New Business

Alan Massie stated that the Federal Government was interested in the deprecation of the DES encryption algorithm and normative references to NIST documents having to do with the DES encryption algorithm from P25 documents. The Federal Partnership for Interoperable Communications (FPIC) will drive this effort.

22. Review of New Assignments

The TR-8 Chair noted an action item for the author of the PAM Tool Schema document to provide a combined comment matrix with author responses.

The TR-8 Chair noted an action item to update the TR-8 projects and documents spreadsheets.

23. Schedule Next Meeting

The TR-8 Chair noted that TIA staff has determined that the October 2018 face to face meeting is scheduled for Oct. 16 – 18 in San Antonio, TX.
